Regular freelance work

→ **Gaydio: Content Producer & Cover Presenter**

Producing content for the world's biggest LGBTQ+ radio station. My main focus is on their Manchester Output, writing scripts for 'The Exchange', the discussion based evening show, where I am also a trained output producer, so I fix things when they break. My role also involves interviewing people for the show, I've interviewed names such as Jake Graf, Susie Green & Lucy Spraggan with some of these gaining airtime on Gaydio's national output on Emma & Dean's drivetime show too.

→ **National Citizens Service: Workshop Facilitator**

Hosting workshops on storytelling and communication skills to groups of up to 90 young people aged 15-17 years old during the NCS summer and autumn programs.

→ **YoungMinds: Amplified Programme Youth Advisor**

The NHS England funded programme working to develop the participation of children, young people and their families at every level of the mental health system.
